Our Mission

Access propels middle school students who have been historically underserved through high school and on to college and career success with enrichment, counseling, and scholarships.

This year, Access Academies:



Supported 512 students — from middle school through college — with individualized mentoring, guidance, and advocacy.



Funded over \$759,411 in high school tuition scholarships and registration, technology, and testing fees so that 191 students could attend one of our 20 private, scholarshippartner high schools.



Launched Access 2 College (A2C), an exciting new college-prep initiative that guided Access high school juniors and seniors through four critical areas: writing, leadership, career exploration, and college planning.



Awarded 44 collegians the Access College Scholarship — worth up to \$3,500 per student over the course of their college career. We have provided over \$33,754 in scholarship funding since 2020.



Helped Access students and their families apply for the My Missouri Scholarship Promise Program and set up MOST 529 college savings accounts.

Access Academies partners with 26 private, college-preparatory schools and has supported students in more than 47 local high schools across the St. Louis region. This academic year, Access served a total of 512 students in 3 partner middle schools, 39 area high schools — including 20 private, college-preparatory schools — and 46 colleges and post-secondary institutions across the country.




