Access was founded in 2005 by a group of St. Louisans convinced that education was the most enduring path out of poverty. Embracing an innovative model that emphasized longer school days, a challenging enrichment curriculum, and 11+ years of individualized counseling, they started the first academy with 15 students in a single South City middle school.

Enrichment

Access offers over 1,000 hours of afterschool and summer enrichment programs to challenge students in important STEM subjects like robotics, coding, and computer science, as well as in key areas such as leadership and character development, entrepreneurship, and the arts.

Counseling

Starting in 6th grade and continuing through college, our Graduate Support Directors build strong, enduring relationships with each student, providing individualized mentoring, guidance, and advocacy at every step of their 11+ year educational journey.

Scholarships

At Access, we believe in equity: that every student should have every chance to thrive every day. Since our founding, Access has contributed more than \$9 million in financial scholarships to high school and post-secondary students. It's an investment that reduces financial barriers for our families and uplifts the St. Louis region.

Board Commitment

- Commit to a 3-year term on the Access Board
- Attend and actively participate in 75% of all Access Board and committee meetings. The Access Board meets 5-6 times per year and committees meet either bi-monthly or monthly
- Provide support and feedback to the Executive Director, staff, and fellow Board Members
- Actively recruit a replacement Board member when your term is ending
- Be responsible for at least one relationshipbuilding activity per quarter (i.e., invite potential supporters to coffee to meet with the Executive Director, etc.)
- Give an annual financial contribution to the best of your ability, considering Access as one of your top charities for financial support
- Attend Celebration Dinner and other fundraisers
